A New Approach

- Put more control in the hands of the analyst, not the web programmer
- Build the right team (combo of in-house and external): info designer, graphical designer, data analysts, GIS analyst, web programmers, DBA, system engineer
- SCRUM (Agile development) beginners
- Iterative with continual user input



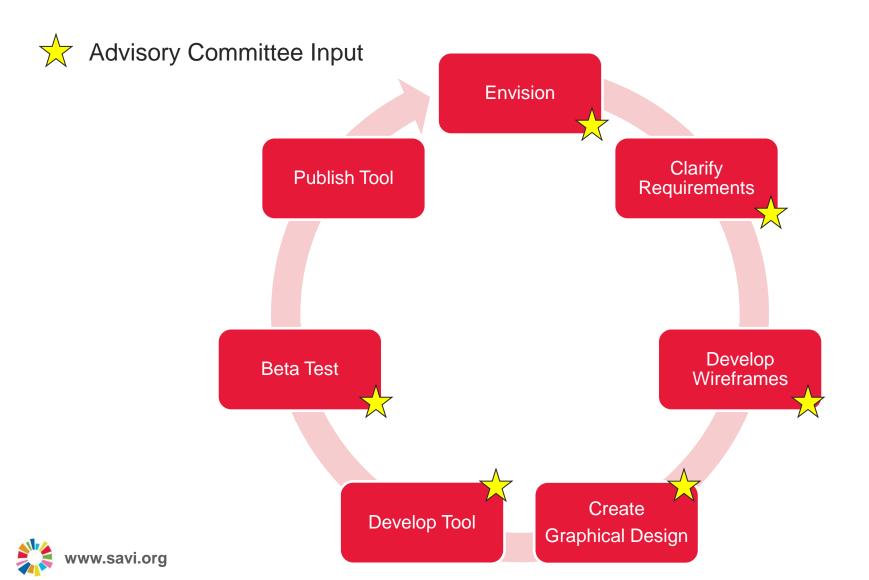
Advisory Committees are Key

- New committee for each tool/use case
- Members: Users, partners, and stakeholders
- Feedback on every stage in the process

- Builds champions from the beginning

3 The Scope of the Work

Indy Vitals is envisioned to have three levels of depth:

- Interested Citizen: A simple dashboard that provides graphic indicators of how a community is doing for each of the indicators, and perhaps composite indicators.
- Organization: A more in-depth view of the indicator, including both temporal and geographic
 comparison graphics and tables, with some indicators broken down to the next level (such as by
 race). This level will provide the level of data required in many grant applications, for example.
- Policymaker: A highly complex view intended to help policy makers, funders, and program
 evaluators understand the complex variables driving each indicator. This will be SAVI Advanced,
 with each indicator linked to a pre-determined set of data in SAVI Advanced.

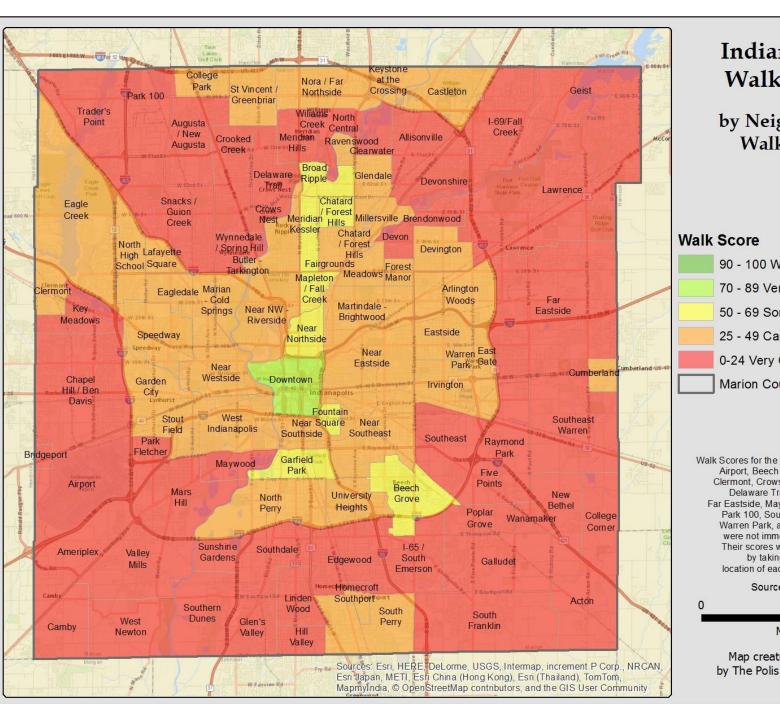
4a. Functional requirements

- Summary of Web Pages (See Appendix for wireframes, which are intended to communicate the
 concept of the website's functionality. The graphical design will be created by a graphic designer
 based on the wireframes):
 - a. Home page with general overview and map
 - User will have the ability to select a neighborhood from a map or list and then view an interactive report for that neighborhood.
 - b. Interactive neighborhood report with 3 levels of detail:
 - i. Simple overview dashboard: The neighborhood-specific report will include a dashboard with data presented in a concise, meaningful way that with a quick look tells the reader how a neighborhood he/she selects is doing relative to the county, to itself, to other communities and and look at which neighborhoods are "healthy." This will be similar in nature to the dashboard view on indianaim pact.org (the metrics, comparisons, visual cues, and graphical design will differ)
 - There will be a short demographic overview/exec summary profile at the top of the dashboard page that links to the SAVI community profile for more detail. This section needs to be graphically separated and neutral (i.e., no "good" or "bad" indications in this section)
 - a. Population, median age, median household income, and poverty rate
 - b. also include link to related neighborhood association website(s)
 - 2. The advisory committee likes the red/green coloring and prefers not to

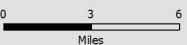

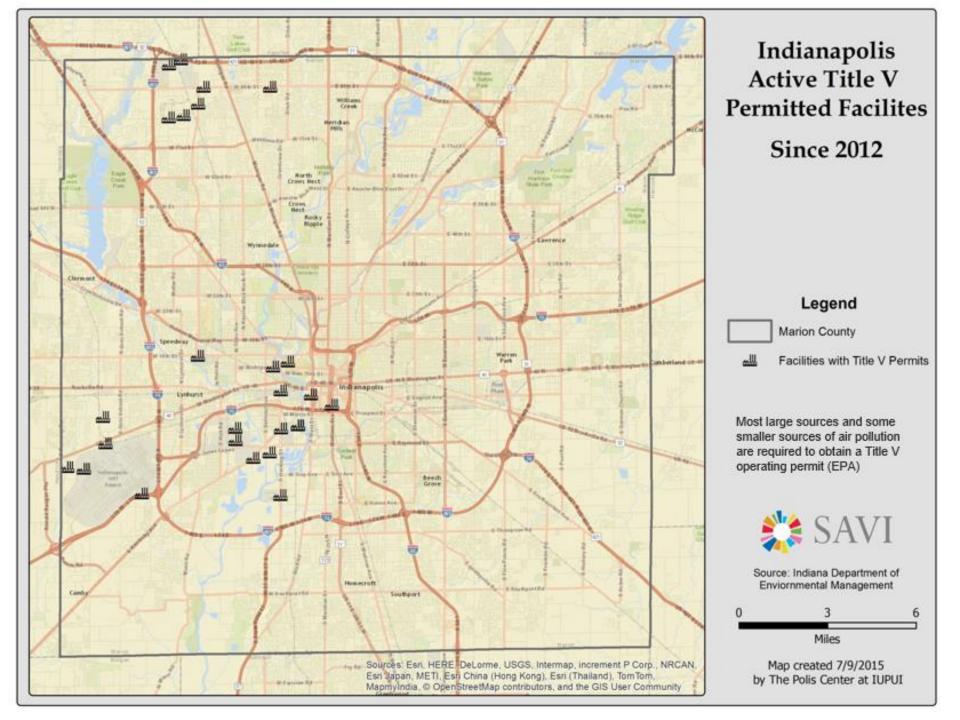

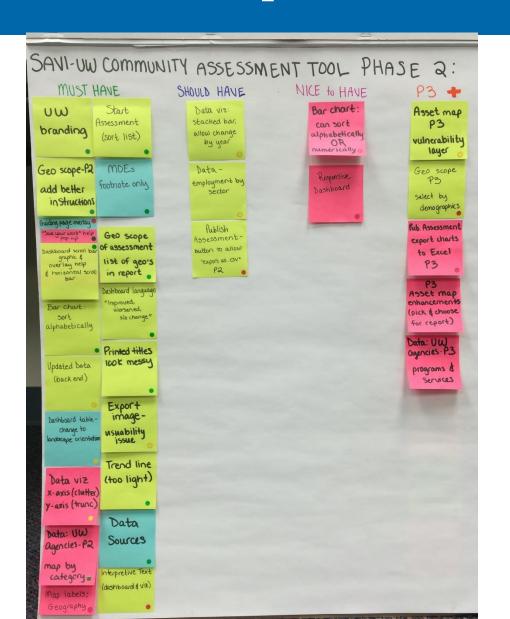


Neighborhoods Sorted by Bachelor's Degree Attainment (Population %)
