



 - Goal: Stronger, expanded NNIP Network

Example Tactics in the Next 90 Days



- Engage local and national stakeholders to share Chicago affordable housing preservation example
 - Strategy: Increase understanding of the network's approach & insights; expanded roles & engagement of the NNIP network
 - Goal: Impact on local policy & practice

Example Tactics in the Next 90 Days



- Develop cross-project concept template
 - Strategy: Expanded roles & engagement of the NNIP network; upgrade our infrastructure to transform NNIP; resource the plan with diversified funding
 - Goal: All 3

- More opportunities for cross-site collaboration
- Opportunities for national exposure of your work
- New ideas and lessons from increased engagement with external stakeholders

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Next Implementation Steps



- Finalize working language on mission and values
- Identify quick wins, such as
 - NNIP Partners Meeting agenda aligned with strategy
- Refine 12 month priorities, such as
 - Communications and branding
 - New strategy on potential partner development
 - Plan for documenting impact
- Begin piloting new ways of working
