NNIP—Critical Role to Play

Barrage of data

- Informed interpretation

= NOISE

Much to Gain from Open Data

Greater access to valuable information

New tools to sift, analyze, present

More interest in data and policy

Risks/Challenges

• Risks:

- NNIP partners could be seen or act as barrier to open data
- NNIP partners could become less relevant as more organizations move into the data space

Challenge:

Bringing unique perspective to open data movement
