

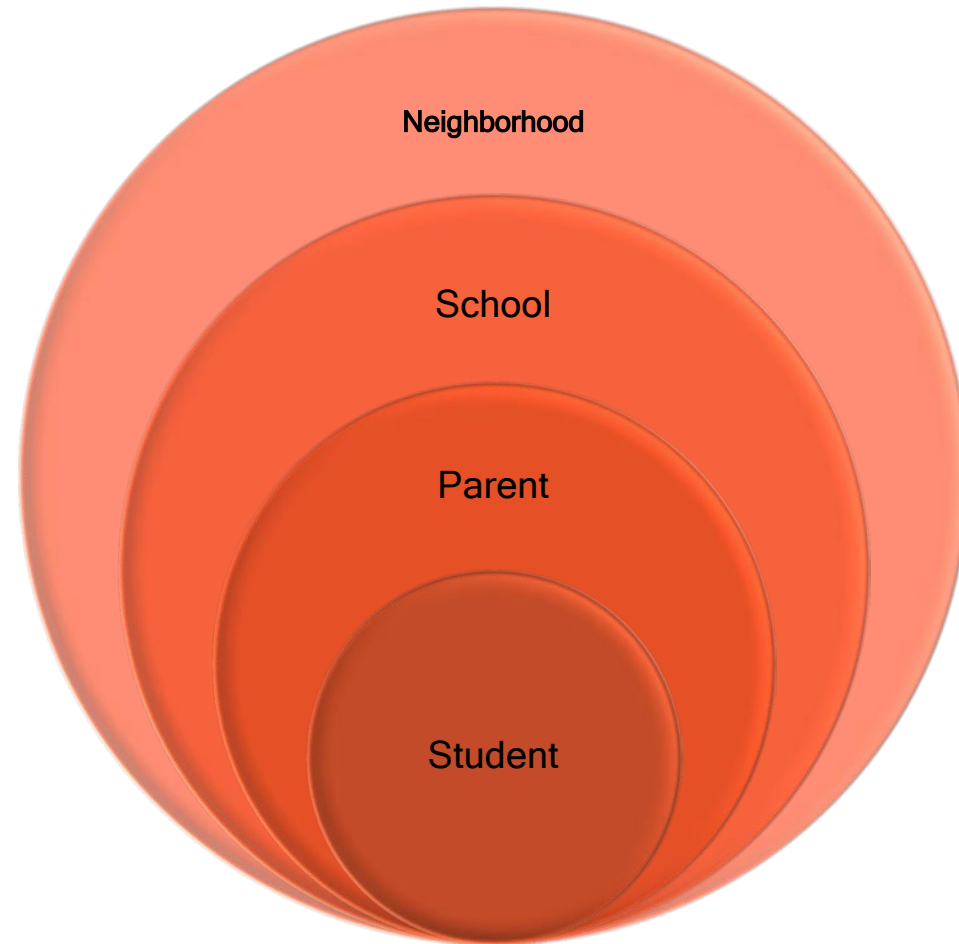

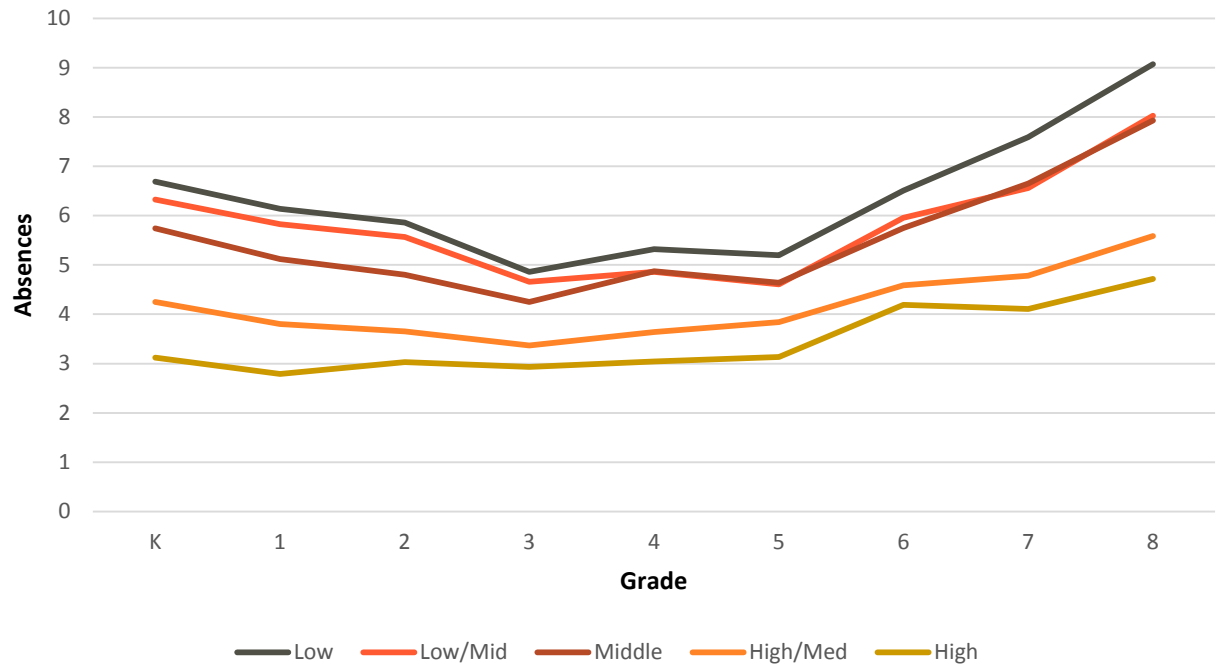

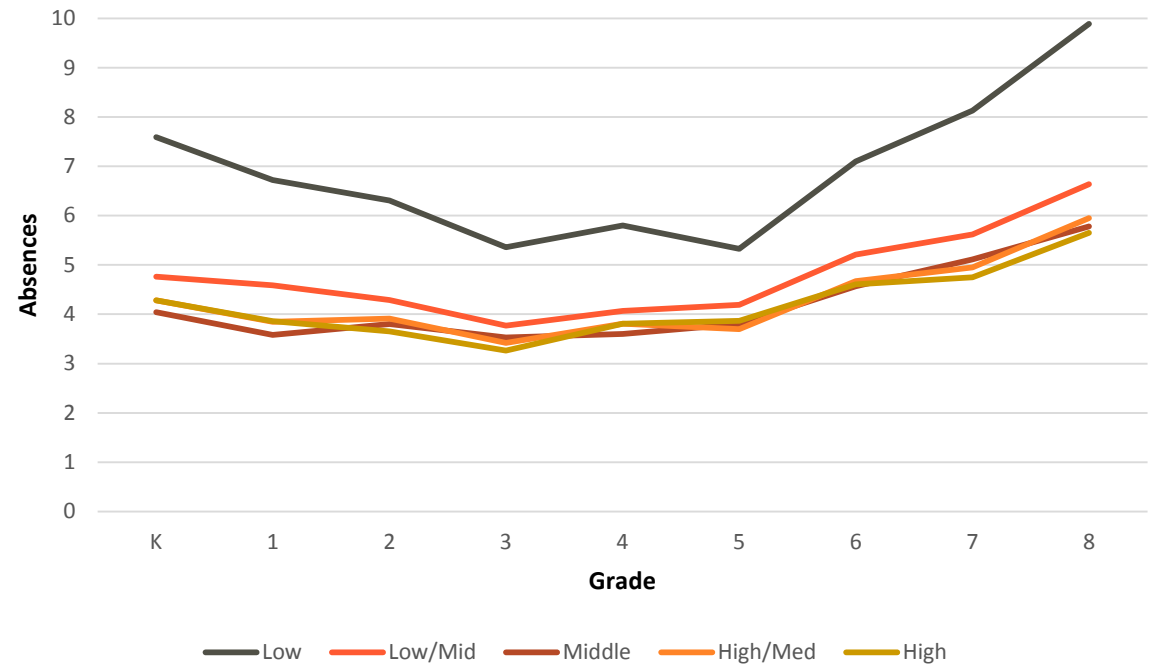


Preliminary Results
